### OPOS (One Person One Salary) Principle

- A letter issued on 17 October 2011 from this Department to all Secretaries General advising that it is now a requirement that public servants who sit on state boards in an ex officio capacity or on behalf of their parent Department/organisation or who may be nominated to such board positions independently of their public service employment should not be paid remuneration in the form of board fees when serving in such a representational capacity and the criteria previously used to determine the eligibility of public servants to receive board fee payments no longer applies in any such cases.
- The only exception to this rule is in relation to worker directors on the boards of commercial state bodies who are exempt from the OPOS principle.
