

National Cancer Strategy 107.

- Publication of the Cancer Strategy should not be taken as an indication to release additional resources outside of an estimates process that considers competing health demands.
- The Cancer Strategy is just one of a number of funding requests submitted by D/Health in 2017, some others include, National Drugs Strategy 2017-2020 (**€35m**), Electronic Health The Cancer Strategy submitted by D/Health outlines a funding requirement of €2.6bn over the next 10 years. This funding is required to cover additional staff, capital and oncology drugs.
- Records (**€800m**) and Health Mobility (**€100m**).
- It is not feasible to look at the Cancer Strategy as a singular issue. It must be considered in the context of other requests and strategies, other health service pressures, and the likely resources available.
